

# Affiliation with Vision 100 Resources

## Introduction

- Until the end of 2005, affiliation with Vision 100 was a fairly *ad hoc* affair. At that time, we clarified the fact that V100 works essentially as a “service provider” to affiliated churches. The actual *membership* of V100 is limited to the Committee. Individuals churches, or their leaders, are not members of V100, with voting rights, but more like “clients” who obtain services from V100.
- There three “tiers” involvement:
  1. *Members*: the Committee members;
  2. *Partners*: those churches or pastors with whom we are affiliated and who make use of V100 services; and
  3. *Supporters*: those churches or individuals who provide financial, practical and prayer support for the work.

## Partnership benefits

- Access to V100 written and people resources.
- Members of V100 partners and supporters network.
- Option of using V100 IT support team for overseeing your church's IT needs.
- Church leadership receive two-monthly 'Committee snippets' with updates on the plans and vision of the network.
- Invitation to participate in V100 network programs: Prayer days (1-3:15pm, Sunday before Australia Day, Reformation Day and Pentecost Sunday), Leadership Conference (Wednesday 4-9pm the week of Reformation Sunday), V100 Sundays (Sunday before Reformation Sunday).
- Church members receives quarterly Vision 100 newsletter.
- First priority in seed-funding and wide promotion of approved church-planting initiatives
- Church leadership and Bible College students receive monthly prayer email compiling prayer requests from member churches.
- First priority in access to Bible College student mentoring and Church Planter training program.

**Partnership obligations**

- Promotion of V100 core values and network.
- Participation in V100 network programs: Prayer days, Leadership Conference and V100 Sundays
- Willingness to occasionally share preachers among other network churches.
- Willingness to volunteer suitable members for service on V100 committees.

**Partnership criteria and establishment process**

- Partnership is open to both individual pastors and to churches.
- The criteria upon which Partners would be selected are:
  1. if they shared our core values;
  2. if there was a genuine, practical involvement in the work of church planting, and training people for church planting, in which Vision 100 is involved;
  3. if the Vision 100 Committee decided to specifically invite them to become Vision 100 Partners;
  4. if the partners choose to accept this invitation and abide by the obligations.
